






Colombia's OC Dashboard







Open contracting benefits in local infrastructure management reforms

Dhangadhi, Nepal 2019 - 2020



Full traceability on physical & financial progress

More than 300 small-scale projects annually to build roads, gutters, bridges and other structures

Preparing & monitoring a project takes much less time Municipal staff save 3.5 hours on average when generating a contract for a project and monitoring its progress - an efficiency gain of 75%

Project amendments decreased 2% of projects had amendments. down from 13%



Service delivery

Reported problems get fixed The municipality fixed, issued warnings or took other action on 15% of feedback reports



High-level oversight

Senior officials mandated to visit all construction sites

Regulations introduced in 2020 require senior figures to visit all project sites; in 2019, visits were reported at 46% of sites

Senior officials have better information

Self-reported confidence in having enough information to oversee projects (score out of 10): Mayor/Deputy - 8; Chief Admin. Officer - 8; Divisional Engineer - 7



Citizen engagement

New citizen complaints channel Monitors filed feedback for 40% of projects in 2020, up from 25%

Citizens can monitor projects more easily

100% of civic monitors say it is 'easy' to access project information; before reforms, 90% said it was 'hard'

Lessons learnt

1. **Continual engagement and change management** across stakeholders (not a one off) especially with civil society which help scale reform, foster trust & protect progress

2. **Use secondary regulations** to implement measures like the Open Contracting Data Standard in all systems (and put into eGP specifications)

3. Diverse & sustained teams needed with a mix of skills

4. **Government using data itself** is vital to improving data quality for all users = growing a performance culture

5. Use **KPIs** and their regular measurement to track implementation of the reforms

6. Value of a specific **oversight unit**, well resourced to monitor all procurement going forwards
